To achieve these goals and uphold these values, we have established the following rules of <u>conduct:</u>

Fair Play for Players:

- » We are a team, we win and lose together.
- » I am always punctual and reliable for training and matches.
- » I apologize after a foul and shake hands with the player.
- » I represent FC Wacker positively in public and act in the best interest of the club.
- » I wear FC Wacker clothing during training, matches, and tournaments.
- » I greet coaches and teammates with a handshake.
- » I follow my coach's instructions and accept their decisions.
- » I am responsible for having my full training and match equipment.
- » I take care of training materials.
- » I am willing to contribute to FC Wacker Biberach both on and off the pitch.
- » I understand that alcohol, nicotine, and drugs are harmful to my health and have no connection to sports.
- » As an active player, I am aware of my role model function for younger players and behave accordingly.

Fair Play for Coaches and Officials:

- » We are a team, we win and lose together.
- » I represent FC Wacker Biberach positively in public and act in the best interest of the club.
- » I respect my colleagues' areas of responsibility and seek personal discussions in case of disagreements.
- » I abstain from alcohol and nicotine during youth matches.
- » I treat and accept all players equally (regardless of character, nationality, personality) and act as a friend, helper, and supporter for them.
- » As a coach or official, I set an example for young players and behave accordingly.
- » I ensure fairness and sportsmanship in my interactions with all involved (players, referees, coaches, spectators, parents, etc.).
- » I am responsible for the public image of my team.
- » As a youth coach, I ensure that all players get playing time.
- » I prepare for training and matches, further my sports education, and stay open to new content.
- » I am always punctual and reliable for training and matches.
- » I greet players and parents with a handshake.
- » I wear FC Wacker clothing during training, matches, and tournaments.
- » I take care of training materials.

Fair Play for Parents:

- » We are a team, we win and lose together.
- » We accept the decisions of the coach and referee and do not interfere with the game.
- » I greet other parents and coaches with a handshake.
- » I contribute to FC Wacker by helping at matches, tournaments, and events.
- » I regularly accompany my child to games and tournaments.
- » I set a positive example at the sports ground and in the team environment and refrain from alcohol and nicotine.
- » I represent FC Wacker positively in public and act in the best interest of the club.
- » I support my child in following the rules of conduct.
- » I respect and appreciate all club members, referees, opposing players, and spectators.
